

A Resolution on the Plan-B Contraceptive

1. Whereas, Plan-B is only available over the counter for women over the age of
2. Seventeen; and
3. Whereas, women under the age of seventeen must be prescribed to obtain Plan-B;
4. and
5. Whereas, Plan-B is meant to be taken up to seventy-two hours after unprotected sex
6. and is intended to prevent pregnancy if other forms of contraception fail or
7. none was used at all; and
8. Whereas, Plan-B is not the same as the abortion pill (Mifepristone); and
9. Whereas, in the United States, seven in ten women who had sex before the age of 14
10. report having had sex involuntarily; and
11. Whereas, In the United States, six in ten women who had sex before the age of 15
12. report having had sex involuntarily; and
13. Whereas, nationally, nearly one million women under the age of twenty become
14. pregnant each year; therefore, be it
15. **RESOLVED** by this student congress assembled that: the Plan-B contraceptive will be
16. available over-the-counter for all women able to bear children.
