

## **The Latin American Marshall Plan of 2012**

1 Be it enacted by this Student Congress here assembled that:

2 **Article I:** All Latin American countries, including those in the Caribbean, will be  
3 eligible for aid from the United States.

4 **Article II:** Section A: Aid shall be defined as either monetary or physical aid given to  
5 a country.

6 Section B: In order for the aid to be given, the country making the request  
7 must open a free trade agreement with the United States and must keep  
8 records of all spending done with aid money in a transparent fashion that  
9 the United States may ask for at any time.

10 **Article III:** The provisions of this bill shall take effect on July 1, 2012.

11 **Article IV:** The United States Department of State shall be responsible for enforcing  
12 the provisions of this bill. Any country found in violation of the demands  
13 made by this bill who has accepted aid will have all aid revoked until the  
14 offense is corrected.

15 **Article V:** All laws or portions of laws in conflict with this bill shall be null and void.
