

A Bill to Limit the Amount of Caffeine in Energy Drinks Sold in Schools

1 **Article I.** Energy drinks be banned from being sold in schools

2 **Article II.** Energy drink shall be defined as any drink with over 50 mg per bottle, can,
3 or other container.

4 **Article III.** The Department of Education in conjunction with the Food and Drug
5 Administration shall be responsible for the enforcement of this bill.
6 Schools shall be prohibited to sell any drink containing more than 50mgs
7 of caffeine. The penalty for schools not in compliance shall be the removal
8 of 90 days worth of federal funding or until the problem is fixed, which
9 ever is longer.

10 **Article IV.** This bill shall go into effect starting in the 2012-2013 school year.

11 **Article V.** All other laws that are in conflict with this new policy shall hereby be
12 declared null and void.
